TECorp International, through its sister company, **VII Cities Energy, LLC**, showcased its current Enhanced Oil Recovery (EOR) project Aug. 21-22 at the 2014 Summer North American Prospect Exposition (NAPE South 2014) at the George R. 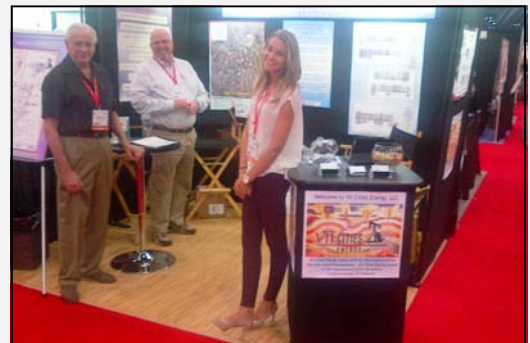

Mr. Thronson said: “The NAPE expo is a well-organized event and marketplace for buying and selling oil and gas prospects and producing properties, seeking investors for prospective energy projects and networking with industry professionals.” Projects exhibited ranged from the Bakken and Marcellus to the Eagle Ford and other shale plays as well as conventional prospects from across the United States. “The response from attendees who stopped by the VII Cities’ booth and studied our project exceeded our expectations, but the work has just begun as we respond to all of the queries and requests for further information,” Thronson added. Qualified interested parties will be granted access to an extensive electronic data site where they can review years’ worth of information compiled by the project team including a Confidential Information Memorandum (CIM) and independent geological and petroleum engineering studies. 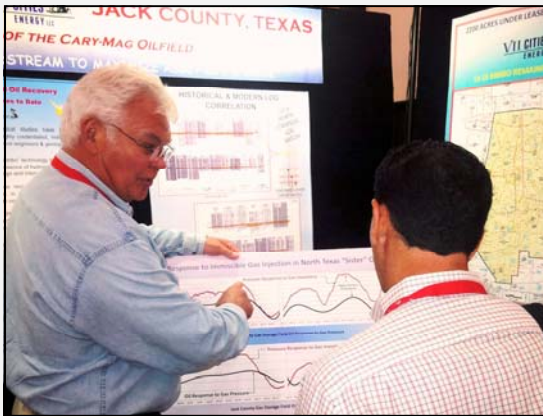


View of 2014 Summer NAPE in Houston, Texas

The Cary-Mag redevelopment project is a unique blend of upstream and midstream components with a projected oil recovery which exceeds 2 million barrels, an NGL extraction stream and a potential simultaneous 5-7 BCF gas storage asset.

TECorp Awarded Feed Study for HARP Slug Catcher

TECorp International is participating in a new Front End Engineering Design (FEED) for a Balance of Plant (BOP), upstream equipment project to support a 200 MMSCFD natural gas processing plant installation in Northern Louisiana. FEED studies are a critical step in the implementation of these projects. TECorp will provide a preliminary Engineering design using its proprietary multi-stage layout for HARP type slug catchers. Additional FEED scope includes: identifying and specifying long lead materials in advance of the detailed design of the BOP as well as providing design criteria, slug prediction analysis, preliminary P&ID's and a refined and detailed project cost estimate.
